- The DHCP reservation for the computer has been configured with the wrong address.
- The computer has not been able to connect to a DHCP server
- The computer object has been deleted from the Active Directory
- It is impossible to give an educated guess as to what is wrong without running additional tests

3) You need to give all staff in the Procurement Unit access to files on a file share. What is usually considered the best way to do this?

- Best practice is to assign each individual user the required share permissions, and then set NTFS permissions to Everyone: Full Control
- All users should be added to a group that is then given the required share permissions. NTFS permissions should be removed to avoid added complexity
- Share permissions should be set to Everyone: Full control. All users should then be added to a Global group that is then added to a Local group, which is granted the required NTFS permissions
- All share permissions should be removed to avoid unauthorized access. All users should then be added to a group that is then given the required NTFS permissions.
